the petitioner for various offences under the Information Technology Act, 2000 and also for various offences under the Indian Penal Code.

2. After the receipt of the complaint by the third respondent, the same was forwarded to the second respondent, by letter dated 20.09.2016 and the same is pending on the file of the second respondent.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that since the matter is to be investigated by a specialized cell, which is well-versed with cyber crime, the second respondent has to allot the case to the specialized agency available in CBCID.

4. In the facts and circumstances of the case, the second respondent is directed to allot the case to the cyber crime cell in CBCID and proceed in accordance with law strictly, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of, with the above direction.
