PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

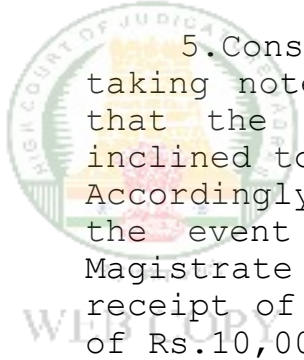
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 452, 323, 506(ii) and 379 of IPC and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act in Crime No. 85 of 2018 and seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to family dispute between the family members the petitioners entered into the house of the defacto complainant, attacked him and stolen some articles from the house of the defacto complainant.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that no one was injured in this case and that the stolen properties have been recovered.



5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and taking note of the fact that no one was injured in this case and that the stolen properties have been recovered, this Court is inclined to grant the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Magistrate concerned within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Tiruchendur or to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.
