PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 341, 353 and 506(i) IPC in Crime No.59 of 2018 seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that when the defacto complainant went for usual patrol, he intercepted the petitioner, who had transported the river sand illegally. At that time, there was a quarrel between them and the Tractor driver escaped from the scene of occurrence. The Tractor along with the property was seized by the defacto complainant. Hence, this case.

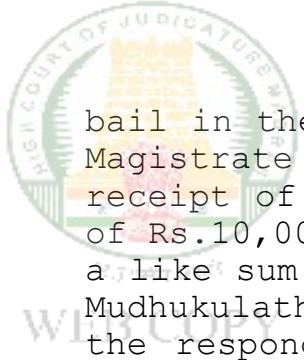
3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that no one was injured in the said occurrence.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and taking note of the fact that no one is injured, this Court is inclined to grant the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on



bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Magistrate concerned within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Mudhukulathur, Ramanathapuram District, or to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders.
