PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 353, 307 and 379 of IPC in Crime No. 93 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.This Court normally does not grant anticipatory bail if the quantity is more than one unit. But then, the counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is aged more than 50 years, having some ailments and he has no previous case.

3.Taking note of the said circumstances of this case, the petitioner is permitted to surrender before the Jurisdictional Magistrate and apply for regular bail. The learned Magistrate shall



accept the surrender and pass orders on the bail petition on the same day in accordance with law.

4. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
