PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under section 420 of IPC, in Crime No.77 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner being a Village Administration Officer of Arasur Village Group of Thiruvadanai Taluk, Ramanathapuram District alleged to have recommended to mutation of revenue records pertaining to the land in Survey Nos.181/1, 172/4 situated at Arasur Village, Thiruvadanai Taluk in the name of first accused namely Pandi S/o.Periyasamy by stating that the first accused is the only legal heir of the Periyasamy S/o.Karuppiah Thevaer by omitting the defacto complainant and another.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution and that the petitioner is innocent person.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also



considering the nature of the allegation made against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner on stringent condition.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvadanai and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m and 5.00 p.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
