Considering the limited scope of the matter, without expressing any opinion on the claim made by the petitioner, I direct the fourth respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 23.04.2018 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner and other necessary parties if any, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
