PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

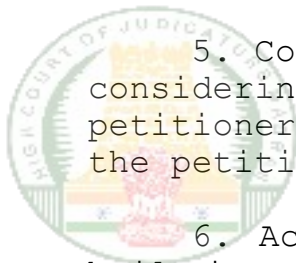
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed A1 to A4 apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(i) of IPC, in Crime No.20 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to wordy quarrel between the defacto complainant and petitioners, the alleged occurrence said to have taken place.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and that the petitioners have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4. Heard the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent and he has submitted that the victim has been treated as outpatient.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the nature of the allegation made against the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Ramanathapuram and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
