Considering the limited scope of the matter, without expressing any opinion on the claim made by the petitioner, I direct the respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 19.12.2017, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, by giving personal opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.



5. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
