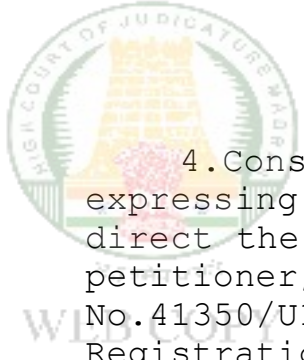

Considering the limited scope of the matter, without expressing any opinion on the claim made by the petitioner, I direct the second respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 04.04.2018, on the basis of Circular Letter No.41350/U1/2017, dated 20.10.2017 issued by Inspector General of Registration and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, by giving opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner as well as persons concerned.
