PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

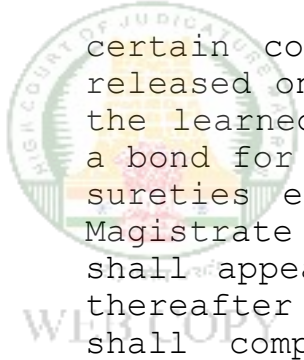
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 352, 506 (i) I.P.C. and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002, in Crime No.317 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail. In this case, t.he petitioner is arrayed as Accused No.1.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to civil dispute between the petitioner and *de-facto* complainant, the petitioner along with other accused persons abused the *de-facto* complainant by using filthy language and also assaulted him and made a severe life threat to him.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that there was a civil dispute pending between the petitioner and the *de-facto* complainant.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with



certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sankarankovil and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
