3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

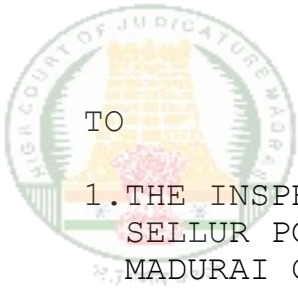
4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent submitted that there are three previous cases pending against the petitioner.
