PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

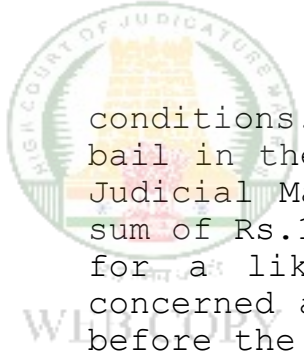
The petitioner/A4, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 294 (b), 323 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.661 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant has taken a sum of Rs.62,000/- from the company, where he was working and at the instance of the owner of the company, the petitioner and others on 11.10.2018, attacked the defacto complainant with hands and they used filthy language and made threaten to his life with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has nothing to do with the commission of offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Government Advocate (criminal side) submitted that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain



conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Trichy and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
