PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

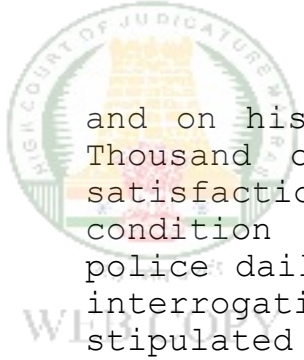
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 379 I.P.C in Crime No.213 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 15.09.2018, the de-facto complainant's driver parked the lorry. When he returned back, he found the said lorry was missing. Hence a case has been registered against the petitioner herein.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been falsely roped into this crime.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit the lorry which is said to have been stolen in the present case has already been recovered.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aruppukottai, Virudhunagar District



and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
