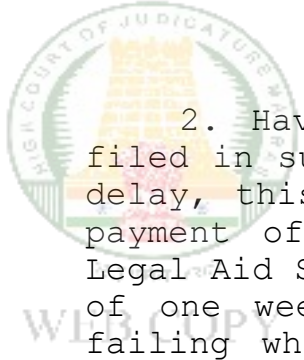

To set aside the order of the Tribunal of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal cum Kulithalai made in M.C.O.P.No.290/2011, dated 10.04.2017 and allow the appeal with costs and render justice.
