Government Advocate (Crl Side) on behalf of the Respondents the court made the following order:-

The petitioner seeks cancellation of bail granted in favour of the accused on the ground that anticipatory bail was granted on the premise that the *de facto* complainant was discharged from the hospital. Actually, when the anticipatory bail was granted the *de facto* complainant is still in patient, this Court does agree with the petitioner's counsel that an erroneous representation has been made. Be that as it may, the fact remains that as of now the *de facto* complainant has been discharged from the hospital. The accused did not misuse the liberty granted by this Court in anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner/accused.

2.Hence taking note of the subsequent developments, the Civil Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed accordingly.
