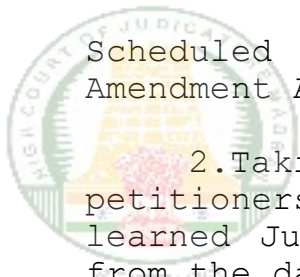

PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners are apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 148, 294(b), 323, 506(ii), Section 4 of the Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002 and 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of



Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015 in Crime No.24 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2. Taking note of the nature of the allegations made against the petitioners, the petitioners are permitted to surrender before the learned Jurisdictional Special Court within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

3. The petitioners shall notify the defacto complainant with regard to the exact date of surrender through registered post. This communication shall be sent at-least one week in advance before the date of surrender. Service of such notice will be taken as service on the de facto complainant for the purpose of statute.

4. On such surrender by the petitioners and their application for regular bail, the Jurisdictional Special Court, is directed to consider the bail application and dispose of the same on the same day.

5. With these observations and directions, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
