ORDER

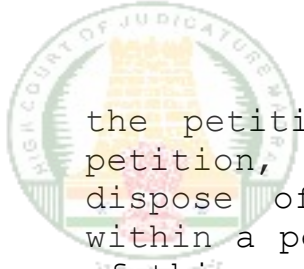
This writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.
