The present Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed by the husband of the detenu, seeking a Writ of Habeas Corpus, directing the respondents to produce the person or body of the detenu, namely, Mohan Priya, aged about 23 years, before this Court and set her at liberty.

2.The detenu is present along with her father. On enquiry, the detenu has informed that she has not married the petitioner and infact her marriage is stated for 10.06.2018 and the petitioner is causing bundles. The detenu desires to be in the custody of her father, the third respondent. The petitioner has been informed that right of his, if any, would have to be established before the



appropriate forum. We find there is no illegal detention.

3. For the above reasons, no further orders are necessary in this Habeas Corpus Petition. Accordingly, this habeas corpus petition shall stand closed.
