PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

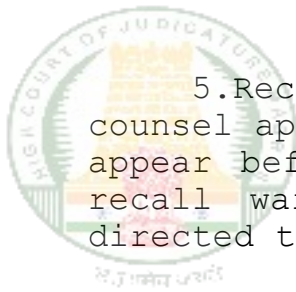
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 353, 307, 379 of I.P.C and Section 4(1) (A) r/w 21(1) of Mines and Minerals Regulation Act, Section 36(A) of Mines and Minerals Concession Rule in Crime No.373 of 2013, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The petitioner was absent on 16.08.2016 during the trial in P.R.C.No.39 of 2016 before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kuzhithurai. Therefore, Non-Bailable Warrant came to be issued.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner shall appear before the Court below regularly on all future hearing dates without fail.

4.If the petitioner fails to appear before the Court below for future hearings, he is entitled to file appropriate petition under Section 317 Cr.P.C. Even if on one hearing, he is absent and no application is filed for condoning his absence, this order granting anticipatory bail shall stand cancelled.



5. Recording the above said undertaking given by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the petitioner is permitted to appear before the trial Court on next hearing date and to file a recall warrant petition. The concerned Judicial Magistrate is directed to recall the warrant on the same day.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
