PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is accused No.5. He was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 17.10.2017 for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 307, 302, 120(b), 109 and 149 of IPC in Crime No. 2104 of 2016, on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.

2.The petitioner is in custody since 17.10.2017 for offences under Sections 147, 148, 341, 307, 302, 120(b), 109 and 149 of IPC. The petitioner has been shown as A-5. Since he did not appear during committal proceedings, non bailable warrant was issued on 04.10.2017.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner undertakes on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner would appear before the Court below regularly on all future hearing dates without fail. Recording the said undertaking, this Court grants bail to the petitioner.

4.(1) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties, each for a



like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai.

(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

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(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**.
