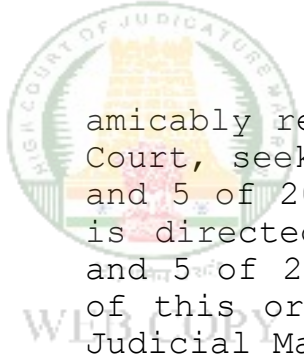
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 r/w. 34 IPC in Crime Nos.4 and 5 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent Police.

3.When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the matter has been



amicably resolved and they have filed a compromise memo before this Court, seeking to close the First Information Reports in Crime Nos.4 and 5 of 2018. Since the issue itself is resolved, the respondents is directed to close the First Information Reports in Crime Nos.4 and 5 of 2018, within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The said closure report shall be filed before the Judicial Magistrate within two weeks, thereafter. Since a direction has been given for closing these First Information Reports itself, there is no question of granting anticipatory bail. These Criminal Original Petitions are ordered accordingly. The Compromise Memo signed by the parties shall form part of the order. It is made clear that question of arrest, does not arise at all.
