PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

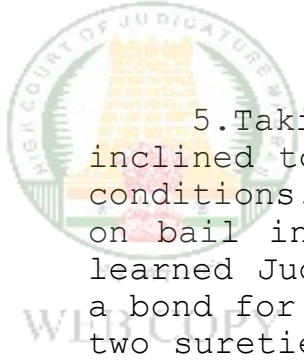
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners/A3 and A4, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 294 (b), 323 and 506(i) of I.P.C., in Crime No.215 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 11.10.2018 at about 06.00 p.m., while the standing complainant standing near Thevar statute for boarding a bus to Madurai, the petitioners along with one Kumaravel and Ramar said to have attacked the defacto complainant and thereby caused injury to him. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have nothing to do with the commission of offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Government Advocate (criminal side) submitted that no one is injured in this case.



5. Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kamuthi, and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
