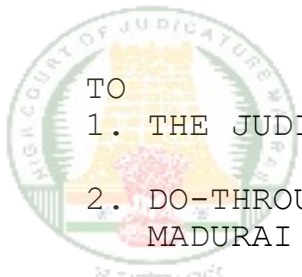
2.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly.
