PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 167, 169, 406, 464, 465, 468, 471, 474, 477, 420 and 120(b) of I.P.C., in Crime No.6 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. This Court had adjourned the matter to enable the accused to cancel the offending transaction. It is now submitted that the offending transaction has since been cancelled.

3. In view of the subsequent conduct of the accused, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Sivagangai, and executing a bond each of them for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C.



4. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
