3.The petitioner had earlier moved the anticipatory bail before this Court on 23.04.2018 and the same was dismissed. This is the second application for anticipatory bail.

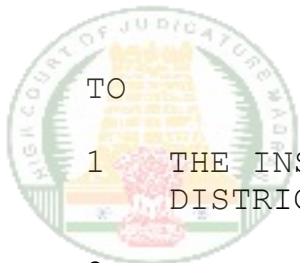
