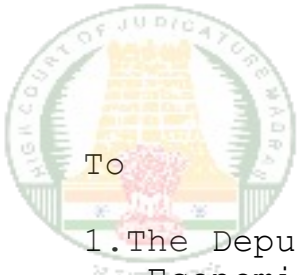
3.The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to approach the respondent police and make a fresh complaint.
