For Respondents : Mr.D.Sivaraman

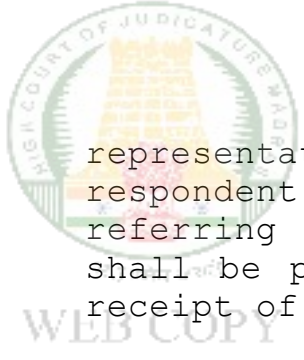
O R D E R
