PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

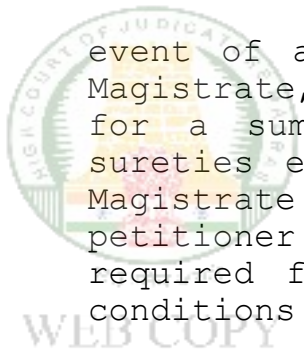
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 323 and 506(i) of I.P.C., in Crime No.27 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) submitted that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.

3. The fact remains that the petitioner hit the defacto complainant near the left ear and leg. Therefore, the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) at the time of surrender to the credit of Crime No.27 of 2018 on the file of the respondent before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Vilathikulam, Thoothukudi District. The said amount can be withdrawn by the defacto complainant. The respondent police shall inform the defacto complainant about the same.

4. In view of the above, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the



event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Vilathikulam, Thoothukudi District and executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
