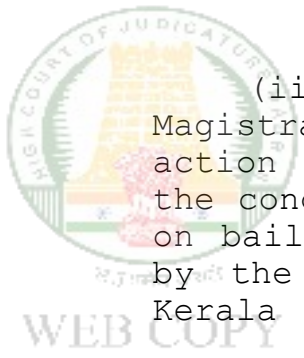
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is in custody since 29.04.2018 for the offence under Sections Sections 341, 294(b), 323 and 336 of IPC, altered into 341, 294(b), 323, 336 and 304(ii) of IPC, in Crime No.270 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.

2. The petitioner is a street vendor. It appears that the occurrence in question had happened on account of a petty scuffle. The petitioner is not having any previous case to his credit.

3. Taking note of the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;

(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai.



(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560].
