PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 341, 323, 324 and 506(ii) IPC in Crime No.328 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent/State.

3.It is alleged that owing to dispute regarding church administration, there was a group clash. The son of the defacto complainant in this case had suffered fracture in his jaw. Though the allegations made against the petitioners are fairly serious, the learned counsel for the petitioners would point out that at their instance Crime No.327 of 2018 has been registered and the present case is a counter case. It is seen that there were injuries on

either side. The first petitioner is also a practicing lawyer.

4. Taking into account the all these aspects, this Court is of the view that the anticipatory bail can be granted to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Madurai and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
