PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

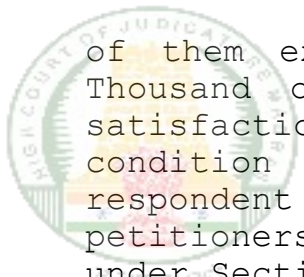
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners are apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 294(b), 323, 324, 506(ii) and 307 of IPC in Crime No.82 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Cr1.Side) appearing for the respondent.

3. The fourth petitioner has already been arrested. Hence this Criminal Original Petition becomes infructuous as far as he is concerned. However, an incident had taken place regarding pasting of wall posters. This Court went through the contents of the FIR. Serious allegations are made only against the first petitioner, Dharma.

4. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed so far as the first petitioner is concerned and this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners 2 and 3 with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners 2 and 3 are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Madurai, and on each



of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners 2 and 3 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners 2 and 3 shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

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5.The petitioners 2 and 3 shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
