ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 353 and 430 of IPC, in the Crime No.89 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), submits that this is a case of large scale sand theft involving as many as 11 lorries. It is further submitted that one of accused escaped with load of sand in lorry from the scene of occurrence.

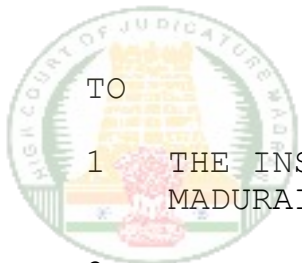
3.Taking into the magnitude of the crime, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners herein.
