ORDER

Heard the learned counsel on either side.

2.The petitioner questions the show cause notice dated 20.10.2014 issued by the respondent. The scope for interference at the stage of show cause notice is rather limited. 3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that after the filing of the petition the respondent has not proceeded further in the matter. He seeks time to offer his explanation.
