PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

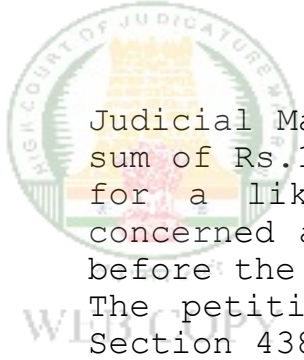
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b) and 506(ii) of IPC and Section 4 of TNPWH Act, in Crime No.66 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to land dispute between the petitioner and the de-facto complainant, the petitioner threatened the de-facto complainant and abused him with filthy language. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent submitted that no one sustained injury in that occurrence and there was no previous case is pending against the petitioner.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned



Judicial Magistrate, Devakottai, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
