PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 506 (ii) and 307 of I.P.C. in Crime No.131 of 2018 and seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent points out that the petitioner is having bad antecedents.

4.This Court went through the contents of the First Information Report. It appears that the petitioner had attempted to unlawfully remove the red sand from the place in question of which the *de facto*

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complainant is a caretaker. The *de facto* complainant has tried to stop the petitioner. This had given rise to the present case and another case.

5. Taking into account all these aspects, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. This Criminal Original petition stands dismissed.
