2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent.

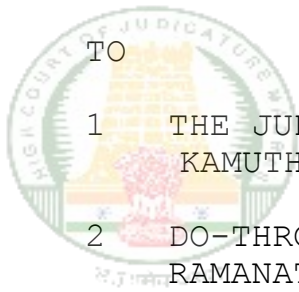
3.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the condition already imposed on the petitioners is fully relaxed.
