PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

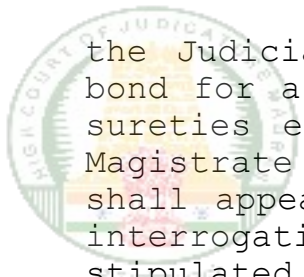
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 294 (b), 323, 307 and 506 (ii) of I.P.C. in Crime No.353 of 2018.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent and the learned counsel appearing for the intervener.

3.Mr.Naresh Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the intervener submits that the petitioner showed disrespect to the deity by entering the temple premises with his foot wear. When this was objected by the Poojari, he was assaulted.

4.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is also a devout Hindu and that he did not indulge in any act as alleged.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before



the Judicial Magistrate Court, Rajapalayam and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
