PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

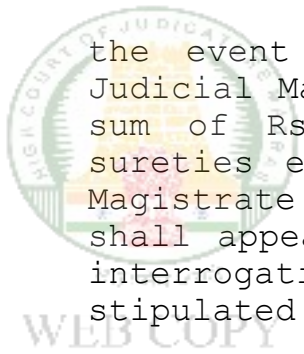
The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 452, 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) I.P.C., and Section 3 of the TNPPDL Act, 1992 and Section 4 of TNPHW Act, in Crime No.203 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police seek anticipatory bail.

2.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the articles belonging to the de-facto complainant around a sum of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) have been damaged.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, undertakes to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) to the credit of the Crime No.203 of 2018 on the file of the Kalakadu Police Station, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Nanguneri.

4.The respondent police is directed to inform the de-facto complainant about this. The de-facto complainant is entitled to withdraw the same.

5.Subject to this condition, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in



the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Nanguneri, and executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
