



4.This Court is of the considered view that a petition for seeking police protection will not maintainable in this case. If the accused persons are claiming exorbitant interest, action can be taken against them only in accordance with law. If the petitioner has given a complaint to the respondent police and the respondent police have not registered F.I.R., it is left open to the petitioner to approach the concerned Magistrate Court by filing a petition under Section 156 (3) of Criminal Procedure Code.

5.This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner.
