PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

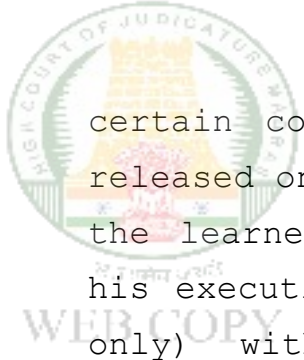
The petitioner/A2 apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 366 of I.P.C. and Section 11(6) read with 12 of Prevention of Children from Sexual Offence Act, in Crime No.41 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the first accused fell in love with the victim and had had given false promise to marry her and had sexual intercourse with the victim. The petitioner/A2 is the friend of first accused, who arranged transportation and residence at Kerala for the first accused and the victim. Hence, a complaint has been registered.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, who would submit that the petitioner is only a friend of A1 and he has nothing to do with the alleged occurrence and he is innocent.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent submitted that investigation is pending.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with



certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judge (FAC), Mahalir Neethimandam, Thoothukudi and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judge concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
