PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

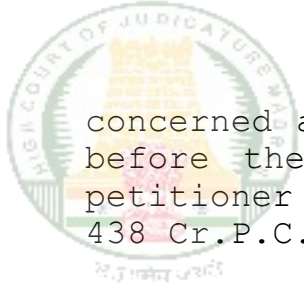
The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 452, 323, 506(i) I.P.C and Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Women Harassment Act, in Crime No.01 of 2017, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to civil dispute between the petitioner and the defacto complainant, the petitioner abused the defacto complainant with filthy language. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that after completing the investigation, charge sheet has been filed and the same was taken on file as C.C.No.57 of 2018.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Devakottai and on his executing a bond for a sum of RS.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate



concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate Court on receipt of summon. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
