

well as the respondent and perused the materials available on record.

5. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent strongly objected to transfer the O.P No.2862 of 2017 on the file of the VII Additional Family Court, Chennai.

6. Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, as well as considering the well settled law that convenience of woman has to be taken into consideration at the time of considering transfer applications as held by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the judgment reported in **2008 (9)SCC 353 (Arti Rani @ Pinki Devi and another Vs. Dharmendra Kumar Gupta)**, I am inclined to allow the present petition.

7. Accordingly, this petition is allowed with the following directions:

- (i) *The learned VII Additional Family Court, Chennai, is directed to transmit the entire records in O.P.No.2862 of 2017 to the file of the Sub-Court, Virudhunagar within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.*
- ii) The Sub-Judge, Virudhungar after obtaining the records on transfer, is directed to try along with H.M.O.P.No.131 of 2017 and dispose of both the cases, within a period of three months thereafter, in accordance with law.

No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
