PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 341, 353 and 307 I.P.C., in Crime No.195 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that there was a dispute between the petitioner and the defacto complainant, due to which, the petitioner and other accused persons assaulted the defacto complainant and threatened him with dire consequences. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the defacto complainant was assaulted on 23.10.2018, by unidentified persons. The petitioner is falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. Hence, he prays of grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) for the respondent submitted that the injured persons has been discharged from the hospital.



5. Taking note of the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Pudukkottai and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
