Heard Mr.C.Venkateshkumar for M/s.Ajmal Associates, learned counsel appearing for the appellant, Mr.K.K.Senthil, learned counsel appearing for the first respondent and Mr.VR.Shanmuganathan, learned Special Government Pleader, appearing for the respondents 2 and 3.

2.The learned counsel appearing on either side would submit that the issue involved in this Writ Appeal is covered by the Judgment of this Court in **A.Solamalai Vs. Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission** [W.A(MD)No.5 of 2017, etc. batch, dated 10.04.2017]. Thus, following the said decision, the Writ Appeal is allowed and the order, dated 07.10.2016, made in W.P(MD)No.140 of 2016, is set aside and the first respondent/ TNPSC is directed to consider the grant of appointment to the appellant in the post of Typist, as per her ranking, subject to the appellant being qualified in other respects, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this Judgment. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
