PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

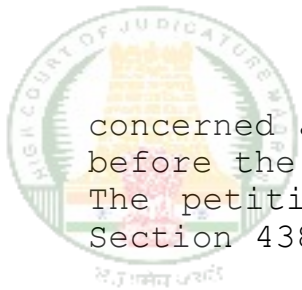
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused No.4 apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 379 and 411 of IPC, in Crime No.101 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent.

3.The case is involving theft of 25 kilograms of fish. The co-accused in this case was granted relief by this Court on condition of deposit of Rs.2,000/-. Likewise, the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.2,000/- in the Crime No.101 of 2018 before the Jurisdictional Magistrate Court. The defacto complainant is entitled to withdraw the same.

4.Subject to this condition, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain other conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Ramanathapuram and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate



concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
