2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side).

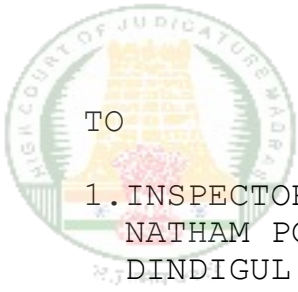
3.This Court had already dismissed the earlier orders in Crl.O.P(MD).Nos.17484, 17485 and 17512 of 2018 by a speaking order.
