4. The learned Additional Government Pleader submits that the said representation would be considered on merits by taking note of the objections made by any rival group.

In the light of the submissions made by both parties, without expressing any opinion on merits, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation on merits and in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
