4. The petitioner has sent a representation dated 19.04.2018 to the third respondent seeking regularization of his service as permanent Sweeper and since the same has not been considered so far, the petitioner is before this Court with the present Writ Petition for the reliefs as stated above.

Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner in the present Writ Petition, without going into the merits of the case, a direction is given to the third respondent to consider and dispose of the representation made by the petitioner dated 19.04.2018 on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
