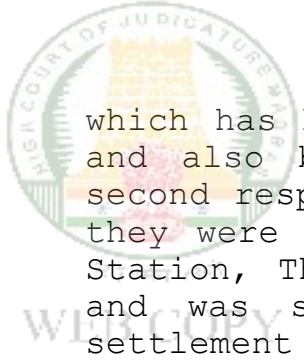
ORDER

The Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in Crime No.117 of 2015, on the file of the The Inspector of Police, All Women Police Station, Thirumangalam, for the alleged offence under Sections 498(A) and 506(ii) of IPC.

2.The case is still at the stage of investigation. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3.A joint memo of compromise has been filed before this Court,



which has been signed by the petitioners and the second respondent and also by their respective counsel. The petitioners and the second respondent were also present in person before this Court and they were identified by the Inspector of Police, All Women Police Station, Thirumangalam. This Court also enquired both the parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4. Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the First Information Report pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **2017 9 SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujath)**, this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C., quashes the First Information Report in Crime No.117 of 2015.

5. This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in Crime No.117 of 2015, on the file of the first respondent police, is quashed and the terms of Joint Memo of Compromise shall form part and parcel of this order. Each of the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five Thousand only) as costs, to the credit of the District Legal Services Authority, Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Madurai, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance in the Registry.
