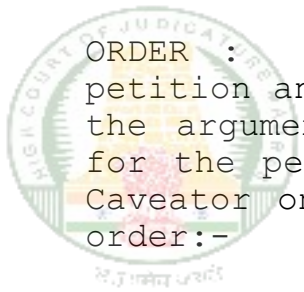

PRAYER IN WA(MD) No.SR22539 of 2018:

To set aside the order dated 19.01.2018 passed in W.P(MD) No.21272 of 2014 and to pass such other or further order as this Hon`ble Court.

Prayer in in W.P(MD) No.21272 of 2014:

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the impugned provisional selection list for Assistant Professor in Government Arts and Science College under Tamil Nadu Collegiate Education Services 2012 (SUB CODE : D02-ENGLISH) published by the second respondent in their website, quash the same in respect of male candidates under Backward Class Ortho category is concerned and consequently consider the petitioner for the post of Assistant Professor in English in Government Arts and Science College under Ortho Backward Class Community Woman category.
